MINUTES: Minutes of the November meeting not available. Review and approval held until February meeting.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Checkbook: Current spendable balance \$50,794.51. This balance does NOT include the stadium project or Kwik Trip sub-accounts.

- Memberships/Sponsorships/Donations 2015/2016 total so far \$5,351.77. 2014/2015 total \$6,105.00.
- **2015/2016 Programs/Calendars**: \$3,808.10. Bills to come. 2014/2015 net \$606.40.
- Concessions: \$600 start-up given to Kellie 8-3-15. 2015 Fall: Gross \$16,524.87/net \$8,016.08. 2016 winter Gross \$9,672.84/net \$5,381.22 plus a deposit received this morning. 2014-2015 Season Concession Total Gross \$47,687.75 resulting in net income of \$21,109.90.
- Cougar Wear Current year gross to date \$15,828 with net \$(470.05). Beginning inventory \$2,294 and starting cash \$216. 2014-2015 Gross \$14,402.62 resulting in net income of \$4,384.02.
- Cougar Cards \$40,931 so far. Highest amount ever. 2014=\$34,355 and 2013 = \$33,013.
- **Golf Tournament** 2015 net = \$2,316. 2014 = \$3,208, 2013 = \$3,507.
- Kwik Trip Account \$1,701.62 this will be paid out to the choir.
- Stadium Project Account \$15,000.
- Pack the Stands Gross \$5,635 Net \$4,542 = amounts paid out to groups 11/04-15 (split equally by 4 soccer teams).
- Two outstanding NSF checks (\$10 and \$60) all "accounts closed". Rick has sent letters to them. One previously listed check for \$30 was collected.

REQUESTS:

- 1. \$584 Pep Band T-shirts/replacements and fill ins 56 t-shirts.
- 2. \$500 Fall Mental Training Sessions with MSU Sports Psychology/Cindra Kamphoff.
- 3. \$1,250 Alpine Ski Gates \$2778.80 total cost. West also contributing.
- **4.** \$1,572 = Gymnastics New foam pad for floor. \$4144 total cost. K&G to contribute \$1000 and give us the old floor. Remainder split between East/West Boosters.

5. \$1,500 – Section Wresting/Triangular Scoreboard for 3rd Mat – Scoreboard will be used for all East hosted events. Want in time for Section tournament. Concessions for this event will bring in about \$2000 profit. Scoreboard is \$6700 new. This is a lightly used unit from MSHSL who is upgrading their units. They are selling for \$3001.00. Wresting and the school will cover remaining cost.

TOTAL REQUESTS ABOVE = \$5,406. M/S/P - Kathy/Dawn

Additional Request – additional funding for Elevator Wall/Graphics = \$1,256.25. Original approval was \$5,000. The quote from Sport Pix (includes elevator door and side of case – addition to current graphic layout) is \$7,714.25. They are providing a "testing" discount of \$1458 for a total cost of \$6,256.25. Requesting additional \$1,256.25 – **M/S/P – Ruth/Darcy**

Food for thought – Metal pictures (vs canvas) to display throughout commons area - 16×24 standouts with standards cost is \$145 (discounted to \$128). With frame the cost is \$220 (discounted to \$190). Replacement panels with backing would be \$100. At one for each activity cost would be about \$5200. These would remain in place for a couple years vs seasonal rotation we use for canvas photos.
