### FINANCIAL REPORT:

**Checkbook**: Current balance \$36,784.43. Available balance = \$35,591.63 after subtracting Kwik Trip fundraiser money.

- Memberships/Sponsorships Deposited to date \$660 for memberships and \$3640 for sponsorships. These numbers match DeDe's numbers but no other category was reduced. Checkbook balance is correct – but this money is likely double counted in one of the other departments below.
- 2013/2014 Programs/Calendars = \$3456.
- Fall concessions Gross \$11,566.67 with Net \$5,289.70. Winter concessions Gross \$2,063.64 no bills received yet. \$600 startup money given to Kellie on 8-12-13.
- Cougar Wear Gross \$12,837.47 with Net \$853.66. Beginning inventory on cost basis = value \$7,087.
   \$300 startup money given to Darcia on 9-16-13.
- Cougar Cards \$32,864 so far. Highest amount to date.
- Golf Tournament \$3,506.75 net.
- 2013 Pack the Stands \$0 balance as all bills have been paid and all proceeds distributed.
- Kwik Trip Account \$1,192.80 net after 2 orders...this will be paid out to the choir.
- One NSF check received thus far for \$50.

#### **REQUESTS:**

- \$419 –Gymnastics. The program is in need of spotting blocks (single and 6-piece) and vault runway. Total cost \$2019. The district is covering \$1200 of this (East \$700 and West \$500). West Boosters are contributing \$400. \$419 covers the remaining cost.
- \$340 Cougar Broadcast Total request is \$680 for four (4) cameras. These are used in the classroom but also for online streaming and posting video online of activities. Retail for these cameras is \$1080 the group shopped Black Friday sales and purchased for \$680. Request is to cover ½ of the cost.
- 3. \$620 Pep Band T Shirts 62 shirts will be replaced through attrition.
- 4. \$1000 Swim & Dive Lane lines total cost = \$2,237.50. Girls and Boys Swimming will contribute \$1,237.50.
- 5. \$696 Jr High Basketball Request is for game shorts. Current are in need of replacement.

6. \$490 – Alpine Ski – Group is requesting funds to purchase ski gates. They break during the course of use. Total amount is \$980 – will be split between East and West.

## TOTAL REQUESTS ABOVE = \$3,565. *M/S/P – Jean/Blaine*

Looking down the road - Items to consider for the future:

- A. We are running out of room in our trophy cases (\$10,000). Add one additional floor to ceiling case (\$1,799 for wood and installation), rebuild three existing cases to accommodate floor to ceiling display. Amounts are without glass and shelving. Todd will bring back these amounts once he receives them.
- B. Water fountain with bottle refill station. A stand-alone chilled refill station is priced at \$2,438. Todd will do more research and come back with more firm numbers.
