## FINANCIAL REPORT:

Checkbook: Current balance $\$ 43,942.30$ (spendable $\$ 42,973.09$ ) - includes Snell check.

- Memberships = \$650 and Sponsorships = \$5355. (\$6150 total in 2013-2014).
- 2014/2015 Programs/Calendars = $\$ 3371.60$. Add $\$ 400$ that was coded to Cougar Den.
- Concessions: $\$ 600$ start-up given to Kellie 8-13-14. Seasonal Detail: Fall concessions - Gross $\$ 14,706.52$ with Net $\$ 6,297.80$. Winter concessions - Gross $\$ 6567.02$ with net $\$ 3365.78$ but may not include all invoices to date. Spring Concessions - Gross \$0 with net \$0. (2013-2014 Season Concession Total Gross equals $\$ 38,952.63$ resulting in net income of $\$ 21,485.48$ ). Having an issue with SAM's Club/Walmart Credit department concerning our charge card. Hope to have resolved by next meeting.
- Cougar Wear - Gross $\$ 12,687.42$ with net of $\$ 2,668.82$. $\$ 400$ of this amount needs to be moved to programs. (2013-2014 Gross Sales of $\$ 16,912.18$ with Net $\$ 3,005.17$ ).
- Cougar Cards - \$34,105...another record. (2013-2014 Total = \$33,013). We do have about \$1700 in expenses but have never netted this out of this total before for reporting purposes.
- Golf Tournament -net $\$ 3,208.2013=\$ 3,506.75$ net.
- Pack the stands - West home event this year.
- Kwik Trip Account - \$969.30.
- 2 NSF checks remain outstanding. 5 Collection letters went out and 3 have been paid. One was returned with no forwarding and the phone number is no longer active. Two that remain outstanding $=\$ 170+\$ 12$ bank fee each.
- A new department will be added for Partner/Fundraiser receipts (examples: Snell, Jersey Mikes, Chipotle, etc.).

## REQUESTS FOR APPROVAL:

1. $\$ 845$ = Graphic for Concession Door - done by Quality 1 Hr Foto.
2. $\$ 700=$ Pole vault poles....GAC will contribute additional $\$ 1400$.
3. $\$ 450=$ Grounds crew to purchase roller for back of zero-turn mower.
4. $\$ 400=$ Alpine Ski gates. They are working our concession stands to help with costs. Mankato West will also pay $\$ 400$ for the shared equipment.
5. $\$ 600=$ Cougar stencil for outdoor fields. $\$ 900$ total cost - Quality 1 Hr will cover $\$ 300$.
6. $\$ 140=$ Medicine Balls for weight room.
7. $\$ \mathbf{2 8 0 0}=$ Hockey helmets $=\$ 1400$ for boys and $\$ 1400$ for girls (total cost $\$ 2380$ boys and $\$ 1470$ girls).

## REQUESTS FOR DISCUSSION:

1. Up to $\$ \mathbf{3 , 0 0 0 . 0 0}=$ Upgrade banners in gym. Made of cloth vs vinyl. State Champions \& Runner Up banners. Different colors for each - would be more gold than yellow. 1 sided @\$192 each ( $\$ 2880$ ) and double sided @ \$308 each (\$4620). Toured gym for discussion. M/S/P - Darcy/Carolyn
2. $\$ 2200$ Air purifiers for locker rooms (\$1100 each) to be used in Football, boys hockey, and girls hockey locker rooms. Plan would be to purchase 2 and move them between locker rooms during the on-season for the sports. Recommendation is to HOLD - Todd Waterbury to follow up with other schools to see if these actually work.
3. $\$ \mathbf{5 , 7 5 6}=$ Upgraded Scoreboard for softball field. Total cost $\$ 15,756-\$ 10,000$ would be contributed from signage fund. Current scoreboard is dated 1970 - this would be moved to Thomas 1 field. Purchase pending \$10K signage contribution. M/S/P - Fred/Shelly

## REQUESTS FOR FUTURE:

1. $\$ \mathbf{2 7 0 0}=$ Weight room equipment - or more which would replace more equipment.
2. $\$ \mathbf{1 4 0 0}=$ Water filling station. This may be part of the renovation as part of the new school project.
3. Football Stadium Project $=$ We need to determine our contribution and how it will be broken up (how much for how many years = example $=\$ 75,000$ total with $\$ 15,000$ over 5 years).
4. $\$ 2200$ Air purifiers for locker rooms (\$1100 each) to be used in Football, boys hockey, and girls hockey locker rooms. Plan would be to purchase 2 and move them between locker rooms during the on-season for the sports. Recommendation is to HOLD - Todd Waterbury to follow up with other schools to see if these actually work.
5. $\$ 5,756=$ Upgraded Scoreboard for softball field. Total cost $\$ 15,756-\$ 10,000$ would be contributed from signage fund. Current scoreboard is dated 1970 - this would be moved to Thomas 1 field. Purchase pending \$10K signage contribution. M/S/P - Fred/Shelly
