MINUTES: Minutes of the May meeting reviewed – M/S/P – Darcy/Jean

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Checkbook: Current balance \$12,233.54. Available balance = \$9,233.74 after subtracting Kwik Trip fundraiser money.

- Memberships/Sponsorships Deposited to date \$720 for memberships and \$4340 for sponsorships.
 Also have \$1,090.47 in donations.
- 2013/2014 Programs/Calendars = \$132.10. Does not include bill for \$880.00 not yet paid.
- Fall concessions Gross \$11,566.67 with Net \$5,289.70. Winter concessions Gross \$21,908.55 with net \$11,791.04. Spring Concessions Gross \$5,477.41 with net \$4,404.74. 2013-2014 Season Concession Total Gross equals \$38,952.63 resulting in net income of \$21,485.48. \$600.00 Startup given 8-12-2013. The seasonal gross/net may vary slightly but final counts for the full year will be correct. There is still a Sam's Club invoice for a couple hundred dollars which is still outstanding as is the YE Pepsi Credit.
- Cougar Wear Gross \$16,912.18 with Net \$3,005.17. Beginning inventory on cost basis = value \$7,087. \$300 startup money given to Darcia on 9-16-13.
- Cougar Cards \$33,013. Highest annual total to date.
- Golf Tournament \$3,506.75 net.
- Pack the stands netted out to \$0 (balance paid out on 11-18-13).
- Kwik Trip Account \$2,999.80 this will be paid out to the choir eventually.
- One NSF check received thus far for \$50.

REQUESTS:

- 1. \$500.00 = Weight room improvements weight collars and bars.
- **2.** \$600.00 = One Pole Vault Collars for pit padding. Pole Vault group will also pay for 1 to total 2.
- **3.** \$450.00 = Three Cross Country GPS bracelets at \$150 each.
- **4.** \$3,000.00 = Wrestling mat recondition. To purchase new mats would cost approximately \$10K-\$12K for the heavier version and \$7500 for the lighter version. Propose instead to recondition both sides for total cost of \$5,784.00. Wrestling and youth wrestling will pay \$2,784 leaving \$3000 to be covered by the Booster Club.

TOTAL REQUESTS APPROVED = \$4,550.00.

PREVIOUSLY APPROVED ITEM NOT YET PAID - \$2500 swim & dive blocks @ \$2500.00 (approved 2-17-14). Can push this expense to 2014-2015 season if needed.

Also for 2014-2015 season – hockey helmets and printing of Cougar Cards (\$826.02).

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Program Books: Discussed format for next year. Decision made to continue with booklet format as done in the past for at least the coming season. Committee: Todd

Cougar Cards/Scarlet Saver: In hands of Carlson Craft to develop proof. Process is ahead of schedule. 12 non-renewals but picked up new businesses to replace them. Card proof supplied to us by July 10th for review and approval. It needs to be returned to CC by July 17th to be ready for August distribution. Count and bind set for first Sunday in August (3rd). Request all board members be available to help count and bind. Current committee: Darcy, Paula and Ruth.

Web Page/Facebook: Web page – no change. Committee: Jill and Darcy.

Golf Tourney: Tentative date set 9/21/14. Committee: John, Fred, Dave Drummer, Tomm Richards and Carey Hayenga.

Membership/Sponsorship: Will need to start again over summer months. Provide better representation at the Fall PAC meeting. 2014-2015 Activity registration will be online.
