MINUTES: Minutes of the September meeting reviewed – M/S/P – Fred/Ruth

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Checkbook: Current balance \$40,950.18.

- Memberships = \$510 and Sponsorships = \$3955. (\$6150 total in 2013-2014).
- 2014/2015 Programs/Calendars = \$5200 so far.
- Concessions: \$600 start-up given to Kellie 8-13-14. Seasonal Detail: Fall concessions Gross \$8,517.87 with Net \$3,096.85. Winter concessions Gross \$0 with net \$0. Spring Concessions Gross \$0 with net \$0. (2013-2014 Season Concession Total Gross equals \$38,952.63 resulting in net income of \$21,485.48).
- Cougar Wear Gross \$10,769.58 with net of \$1,600.98. (2013-2014 Gross Sales of \$16,912.18 with Net \$3,005.17).
- Cougar Cards Sales so far \$33,725...another record. (2013-2014 Total = \$33,013). We do have about \$1700 in expenses but have never netted this out of this total before for reporting purposes.
- Golf Tournament Still being totaled...approximately \$3,000. 2013 = \$3,506.75 net.
- Pack the stands West home event this year.
- Kwik Trip Account account now empty.
- 2 NSF checks remain outstanding. 5 Collection letters went out and 3 have been paid. One was returned with no forwarding and the phone number is no longer active. Two that remain outstanding = \$170 + \$12 bank fee each.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Program Books: Same plan as last year. Work will continue to break even by end of year. Committee: Todd

Cougar Cards/Scarlet Saver: Over \$33k in sales – best ever! Incentives given = 75 sweatshirts given for > 20 cards sold, \$230 in cash awards @ \$1 for every card sold over 20, 251 free cards given at 1 free card for every 10 sold. Current committee: Darcy, Paula and Ruth.

Web Page/Facebook: no update for Facebook or Webpage. Team will maintain Booster Club Twitter Feed. Committee: Jill and Darcy.

Golf Tourney: Completed. Tournament should net just under \$3,000. Discussion about timing for next year's event. Committee: John, Fred, Ruth, Shelly and Darcy are assisting.

Membership/Sponsorship: 4 new members at \$30 each (\$120) and 1 new sponsor at \$650.

Committee: Jill, Lori, Dawn. DeDe Meyer will continue to assist off-line.

Cougar Wear/Cougar Den: New t-shirt to sell for holiday at \$15. Blankets are selling well. Will do an ad blast for holiday says.. Committee: Jean, Darcy, Arlin Penner, and Deb Rabenhorst. **Marketing:** To be addressed in near future. Committee: Darcy, Jean, Dawn and John.

OLD BUSINESS:

- BW's East v West Wing contest = East wins the sales challenge and the Blazing Challenge as well. \$250 win for the Blazing challenge and \$210 from sales receipts of \$1400. Football team wins \$150.
- Stadium Project update = A fundraising group has been developed for the \$350,000 project. Drawings are being worked on. This will be a 3 phase project.
 - 1 Press box and Seating
 - o 2 ticket booth
 - o 3 Plaza

What are our thoughts on seating: Bench seats with backs or individual seats and backs? There will be fewer seats if we go with individual/backs and the cost increases substantially.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Fundraiser request Cherry Berry. % of sales for a day. Could be for either Booster Club or a specific sport. Is the proceeds amount worth it?
- Need to revisit Schwann's proposal however this program is heavily labor intensive.
- Fundraiser this Saturday at SNELL MOTORS. Booster Club can get up to \$10,000 for test drives. About a 15 minute process. \$10/drive or \$20/drive if more than 100 test drives for East. Competition between East and West.
