MINUTES: Minutes of the September 16th meeting reviewed - M/S/P - Darcy/Jean
Guest: Owen Dundas - presented Schwan's fundraiser opportunity: Owen is presenting on behalf of Schwann's as a Schwann's Cares broker. A program would run 45 days at top rates = $\$ 10$ back for every $\$ 25$ e certificate ordered and $20 \%$ of sales during that period. After the 45 days the group payback becomes 5\%. Participating groups need a "captain" to organize the event. Shakopee Girls Fast Pitch participated as a TEST organization this summer and was able to raise $\$ 2700$.

## FINANCIAL REPORT:

Checkbook: Current balance $\$ 57,014.32$. Available balance $=\$ 52,321.52$ after subtracting Pack the Stands money.

- 2013/2014 Programs/Calendars $=\$ 4800$ but no bills received yet.
- Fall concessions - Gross $\$ 10,146.67$ with Net $\$ 8,715.65$. $\$ 600$ startup money given to Kellie on 8-1213. Some bills remain outstanding.
- Cougar Wear - Gross $\$ 12,468.88$ with Net $\$ 3,317.99$. Beginning inventory on cost basis $=$ value $\$ 7,087$. $\$ 300$ startup money given to Darci on 9-16-13.
- Cougar Cards - $\$ 31,809$ so far. Highest amount to date.
- Memberships/Sponsorships/Bricks - Deposited to date $\$ 390$ for memberships and $\$ 500$ for sponsorships.
- Golf Tournament - \$3,101.75 net so far with some deposits still pending.
- 2013 Pack the Stands - $\$ 4,692.80$ net (included in account balance above). Some deposits outstanding but all bills should be paid. Once net is final it will be divided among the 4 soccer teams (MEHS Girls, MEHS Boys, MWHS Girls and MWHS Boys).
- One NSF check received thus far for $\$ 50$.

REQUESTS: Update on past request approvals - the canvas prints are up on the athletic side of the entrance. Enhancements to come - adding a black frame around/behind the prints to help offset them from the wall and conceal the brick. Check them out.

1. $\$ 1,500$ (max approval sought) - V.E.X. Robotics Team - combined East/West. There is currently no funding in place for this team. Group is requesting start-up funds. Both East and West Booster Clubs will be asked to contribute to develop this team for this season. In the future this group will
need to help with fundraising both on their own behalf as well as for the support of the Booster Clubs.
2. $\$ 1,200$ - Homecoming Alumni/Hall of Fame - Request for luncheon and other items. This is a standard annual request.
3. $\mathbf{\$ 2 , 0 0 0}$ - Boys and Girls Hockey Team Bags and Breezer Covers - Team bags will be made locally with the vendor able to repair for repeated seasonal use. Both items will remain with the team and be assigned to players for seasonal-use. Total cost for both teams/both items is $\$ 4,000$. Teams will cover $1 / 2$ of cost for items.
4. $\$ 1,000$ - Boys and Girls Soccer Indoor Goals - 2 PVO indoor Futsal goals (7x10 goal) for indoor skills work and can also be used by PE Classes. Currently using goals not intended for this purpose and they are outdated and in disrepair. $\$ 900-\$ 1000 /$ goal. Soccer will pay for $1 / 2$.

Items to consider for the future:
A. $\quad \mathbf{2 , 4 4 5}$ - Jr High items - VB tops - Black and gold (Qty. 90) - approximate cost $\$ 1530$ and basketballs $\$ 915$. Our Jr High programs are our feeder programs and they need an influx of funding to cover some of these items. Discussion was held and group decided to vote for approval of these items at this time.
